**Applications are invited for the Position of "Health Investigator"**


Applications are invited for interview on job contract basis for 'Health Investigator' in LASI-VIS project at IIPS. The field survey of the LASI-VIS project will be conducted in **four states of India**, namely **Punjab, Karnataka, Kerala and Rajasthan**. For the implementation of LASI-VIS field work in these four states, 4 field teams will be required. The proposed field team composition comprises of **2 Female and 1 Male field investigators, 1 Health investigator and one supervisor**. For each of these four LASI-VIS states, one field team will be recruited, trained and designated for conducting field work.
