The committee members unanimously selected one research paper entitled "Effect of Socioeconomic Inequality in Health on Income and Economic Growth in India" written by Mr. Kaushalendra Kumar and also recommended a partial financial assistance of Rs.10,000/- to for meeting his conference expenses.

The Evaluation Committee also assessed four applications submitted by the Ph.D. research scholars for the financial assistance from IIPSAA to participate in the summer seminar in Germany and South Korea. The Evaluation Committee recommended partial funding of Rs.10,000/- to Mr. Awdhesh Yadav who proposed to participate in the summer school of epidemiology at Ulm university, Germany during July 20-24, 2015.

The followings criteria's were fixed by the committee for evaluating research papers and application of summer seminar.

- 1. The applicant should be the life member of IIPSAA and reference will be given to the research scholars.
- 2. Funding will be provided only to the oral paper presenters.
- 3. The presenters are required to submit the details of financial award/invitation letter from the organizers and sponsors to IIPSAA.
- 4. The presenters are required to submit full paper selected for oral presentation.
- 5. One best paper will be selected for the financial assistance to be given by IIPSAA.

- 6. Based on course curriculum of the overseas workshop (summer school, winter school etc.) one applicant will be provided partial financial assistance from IIPSAA. The curriculum should be related to the applicants PhD topic.
- 7. The overseas workshop should be from a internationally reputed institution and that Institute should be able to provide additional professional capacity beyond IIPS subject domains.
