

1.3.1. Institution integrates crosscutting issues relevant to Professional Ethics, Gender, Human Values, Environment and Sustainability into the Curriculum

IIPS gives special emphasis professional ethics, gender, human values, environment and sustainability into its curriculum and research. The following courses address these crosscutting issues:

Gender and Ethics are the important components of the curriculum at IIPS. Most courses have sections on gender analysis like differentials in mortality, morbidity, health services utilization, feminization of population ageing, female labour force, female migration, marriage, sex ratio, gender gaps in education, etc.

Institute has constituted a “**Students’ Research Ethics Committee**”. Every research proposal based on primary data needs clearance from this committee. This Committee takes care of the ethical issues pertaining to the research projects of the students. IIPS has constituted an “**Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)**” which assists in raising awareness regarding sexual harassment in the campus and redress the sexual harassment related complaints of the students.
