I. TEACHING PROGRAMMES

1. REGULAR COURSES

During the academic year 2022-23, the Institute offered the following regular courses: (a) Doctor of Philosophy in Population Studies/Biostatistics & Demography (Ph.D.), (b) Master of Arts / Science in Population Studies (M.A/M.Sc.), (c) Master of Science in Biostatistics and Demography (MBD), (d) Master of Population Studies (MPS), (e) Diploma in Health Promotion Education (DHPE), and (f) Post Graduate Diploma in Community

Healthcare (PGDCH). Apart from these programmes, the Institute also offers M.A. in Population Studies through distance learning and a postdoctoral fellowship programme. The following table provides a summary of the courses offered, number of students awarded diploma/degree and number of students enrolled during the academic year 2022-23.

i. Doctor of Philosophy in Population Studies (Ph.D.)

The Institute has well qualified faculty to guide students admitted to the Ph.D. programme through a highly competitive process that involves their previous academic records, online entrance test, proposal writing, followed by personal interview.

This academic year, 33 students have completed all the requirements for the award of Ph.D. degree. Appendix III-1 provides the list of successful candidates receiving the degree in this academic year for the award of the Ph.D. degree.

A total of 182 students are pursuing Ph.D. Of them, 63 are recipients of the Government of India Research Fellowship, 87 are recipients of the UGC Fellowship, eight from NFSC Fellowship, three from NFOBC Fellowship and 14 students without fellowship. 13 students have submitted their thesis, and 13 students have presented their Synopsis. The details of the PhD students are presented in Appendix IV.

ii. Master of Arts/Science (M.A/M.Sc.) in Population Studies

The course is of two years' duration. This academic year 33 students qualified for the award of the degree. The list of students receiving M.A. / M.Sc. degree is given in Appendix III-2.

The 30 students currently enrolled for the programme (2022-24) is presented in Appendix IV.

iii. Master of Science in Biostatistics and Demography (MBD)

The course is of two-years duration. This academic year 32 qualified for the award of the degree The list of students receiving MBD degree for this academic year is given in Appendix III-3.

The 31 students currently enrolled for the program (2022-24) is presented in Appendix IV.

iv. Master of Population Studies (MPS)

Holders of a Master's Degree from any recognized universities in relevant social science subjects are eligible for admission to the Master of Population Studies course. In this academic year, 41 students were admitted to MPS with the Government of India fellowship and 42 qualified including one student from the previous year for the award of the degree. The list of students receiving the MPS degree for this academic year is given in Appendix III-4.
