United Nations Expert Group Meeting on Innovative Methods to Measure the Impact of COVID-19 on Mortality through Surveys and Censuses
Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates, 23-26 August 2022

It is my pleasure to inform you that the Statistics Division of the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN-DESA), in collaboration with the UN-DESA Population Division and New York University (NYU) Abu Dhabi, is organizing an Expert Group Meeting on Innovative Methods to Measure the Impact of COVID-19 on Mortality through Surveys and Censuses. The meeting will take place at the NYU Abu Dhabi campus, on 23-26 August 2022.

The meeting is organised under the guidance of the Technical Advisory Group on COVID-19 Mortality Assessment (TAG) established jointly by UN-DESA and the World Health Organization (WHO). As a final output of the Working Group 2 under the TAG, the recommendations produced by the Expert Group Meeting will not only help fill national data gaps in adult mortality in terms of availability, quality and timeliness, but also provide guidance on ways to collect data that can capture the impact of the pandemic (or any future crisis) on adult mortality through surveys and censuses.

The meeting will discuss and agree on a set of proposed recommendations for censuses and surveys based on ongoing research and experiments, and particularly in low-income and middle-income countries. These recommendations will seek to (a) improve adult mortality data collection in terms of quality, availability and timeliness; and (b) generate census and survey data that could be used to measure the impact of epidemics, pandemics and other disasters on adult mortality. The proposed recommendations would cover innovations in questionnaire design; interview methods and sampling strategies, as well as integration of surveys and censuses with other data sources on mortality (e.g., civil registration, health information systems).




Prof. T.V. Sekher could not attend the meeting. Since Prof. D.A. Nagdeve was an applicant, he was not part of this meeting.






