






### **ABOUT IIPS**

The International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS), Mumbai, formerly known as the Demographic Training and Research Centre (DTRC) till 1970, was established in July 1956 under the joint sponsorship of the Government of India, Sir Dorabji Tata Trust, and the United Nations. The Institute is under the administrative control of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.



The Institute served as a regional center for Training and Research in Population Studies for the Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) region. The Institute was re-designated to its present title in 1985 to facilitate the expansion of its academic activities and was declared a 'Deemed University' on 14 August 1985, under the Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. This recognition has facilitated the award of degrees by the Institute itself and paved the way for further expansion of the Institute as an academic institution. The faculty members and the supporting staff belong to a diverse interdisciplinary backgrounds with specialization in some core areas of population sciences, trained in India and abroad.

The Institute is the hub of population and healthrelated teaching and research in India and plays a vital role in the planning and development of the the past years, students from country. During different countries of Asia and the Pacific region. Africa, and North America have been trained at the Institute. The alumni of the Institute occupy prestigious positions at reputed and international organizations, universities, research institutes and non-government organization.

The Institute offers Post-Graduate, Doctoral, and Post-Doctoral courses and one PG Programme through Distance Mode. After completing the course, students of all programmes are well prepared for (i) admission to higher degree programmes in the best universities across the world; (ii) a good career in teaching & research; (iii) a multi-disciplinary professional career; or (iv) independent consultant and specialist in health and development sectors.




### Milestones of CDOE




### **Our Learners**



The total enrollment of distance learners is 144, includes 22% from the development sector, followed by freshers (20%), academicians (11%), health sector professionals (8%), researchers (8%), assistant professors (6%), government officials (5%), and census officials (5%). Other categories include health officials (4%), research managers (3%), individuals from the IT sector (2%), military officials (1%), research institutes (1%), professors (1%), representatives from UNDP (1%), architects (1%), and census employees (1%).

The CDOE has been functioning for the past three decades, from 1995 to 2025. A total of 667 students have been awarded degrees or diplomas from the Centre, including 496 from the Master in Population Studies program, 136 from the Master of Arts in Population Studies, and 35 from the Diploma in Population Studies



There are 150 seats available for admission to this programme. However, the Institute reserves the right to decide the number of students to be enrolled in each academic session depending upon number of applications received.

#### Selection Criteria:

Selection of candidates for the programme will be done by a selection committee duly constituted by the Director of the Institute.

### **Self-Learning Material (SLM):**



- Self-instructional materials shall be provided in hard copy to the enrolled students. The self- instructional programme study materials will also be accessible to all the enrolled students through 'Moodle' platform. The credentials will be given to the students to avail of the 'Moodle' facility.
- A total of 20 papers (detailed given on page no.7) including core, and optional papers are in the programme curriculum.
- The dedicated faculty of the Centre and regular faculty of the Institute have contributed to the development of the study materials. The study materials have been compiled and edited by the dedicated faculty of the Centre. To maintain the quality of the programme, the edited study materials have been sent for review to the outside subject experts.

### ersonal contact Programme:

A contact programme of two-weeks duration will be organized at the Institute in June every year for doubt clearing and interaction with the faculty members. Through feedback forms, the learners will be asked to evaluate the teaching performance. A face-to-face interaction with faculty members and counseling by the core faculty is available during office hours during week days (Monday to Friday).

Components of the Evaluation Process


i. Written Examination (70% weightage)

In order to qualify, a student is required to write examination for 70 credits. Additionally, the learners also have to submit a final term paper for 10 credits and appear in Viva-voce for 4 credits. (Course Credits:70+10+4=84)

\* Student must pass 50 percent of the core papers in the  $\mathbf{1}^{st}$  year to be promoted to  $\mathbf{2}^{nd}$  year.

#### ii. Assignment (30% weightage)

The learners need to submit their assignments through 'Moodle' platform to avail the 30% weightage in the final grade. All assignment questions will be uploaded in the 'Moodle' platform.

#### LIBRARY

Providing an access to demographic information is the most fundamental way of increasing and maintaining the quality of research and education in population sciences. The Library of IIPS is one of the best in the world in the field of Population Sciences. It has around 87, 000 books, 18, 000 bound volumes of periodicals, 17, 000 reprints, 650 audio- visual materials, and subscribes to over 350 (Print + Online) journals.

The library has subscribed to more than 25 online databases i. e. JSTOR, SCIENCE DIRECT (social science collection), SCOPUS, INDIASTAT, etc. The library has digitized and preserved census of India volumes from 1872 - 1941 and possesses Census reports (1872 - 2011), vital statistical reports, NSSO reports, and Registrar General of India's reports. The library is creating an institutional repository i. e. digitizing the institute's publications to provide remote access to its users. Radio Frequency Identification (RFID), Identification of Core Collection of Population Studies, and digitization of State Level Census Volumes of India are the significant activities undertaken by the library now.

#### DATA CENTRE

The institute has a robust Data Center comprising a network attached storage server (NASSTOR) to enable storing and disseminating demographic datasets. It has all essential datasets like the census, various rounds of the National Family Health Survey (NFHS) and District Level Household and Facility Survey (DLHS), Demographic Health Surveys (DHS), Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS), Youth in India, National Sample Survey (NSS), Longitudinal Ageing Study in India (LASI), Study of Global Ageing and Adult Health (SAGE), Annual Health Survey (AHS), etc. which can directly be accessed by the faculty, staff, and students. Online databases of IIPS surveys are also disseminated to the registered users through a web portal.

#### **INFORMATION & COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY UNIT**

The Information Communication and Technology Unit (ICT) of the Institute administers and manages the campus Computer Networks. The institute has acquired 1 - GBPS internet link from NIC under the National Knowledge Network project. The IIPS Local Area Network consists of wired (Fiber Optic) and wireless (Wi- Fi) networks and connects all computers and mobile devices in the Institute. The ICT Unit is equipped with the latest Core i7, higher generation computers, and all necessary statistical software with a mutluiser license to analyze demographic datasets. Some of the essential software available are IBM SPSS Version 26, STATA Version 16, SAS 9. 4, Stat transfer, Arc GIS Pro 2. x, ML Win, and Atlas. Ti, NVIVO 10, Spectrum, Mortpak, Endnote X 7, Grammarly, MS Office 2016. The ICT unit also provides 24 x 7 internet facility to students, staff, and faculty in the campus.

#### **LECTURE HALLS**

The campus comprises six aesthetically designed classrooms equipped with all the required modern facilities. The teaching process at the Institute is made more effective by using the technology tools. These tools assist students to better understand and provide means for visualizing the concepts. The classrooms are equipped with computers, projectors, modern sound systems, overhead projectors, and audio- visual tools. In addition, an architecturally designed seminar hall with the latest technology, such as a multimedia projector facility also available on the campus.

#### **HOSTELS**

The Institute has two hostels for accommodating students admitted to various courses. The rooms in the Hostel are furnished and have adequate living and working space. Each room has a bathroom and toilet attached to it. Mess facilities are available in the hostel and a canteen is also functioning in the campus. Our distance learners avail the accommodation in the hostel during the contact programme after paying a minimum charge.


