#### Report – Awareness Rally based on NEP 2020 to mark launch of NEP 2020

An awareness rally focusing on the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 was organized on 29th August 2025 at the IIPS campus. The rally was formally flagged off by Prof. D. A. Nagdeve, Director & Sr. Professor (Additional Charge), IIPS. Dr. Kunal Keshri, NEP SAARTHI Coordinator addressed the participants and highlighted the importance of NEP 2020 in transforming the Indian education system. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from IIPS Faculty Members, NEP Coordinators, NEP SAARTHIS, First Year Master's and Ph.D. students, who came together to promote awareness about the transformative goals and thrust areas of NEP 2020. The rally began from the Library Building and moved across the campus, concluding at the same point. Throughout the rally, students actively engaged in slogan-chanting and held creative posters that highlighted the key messages of the policy.

Several impactful posters were displayed during the rally, including messages such as "Nai Shiksha Nai Niti Kare Sakar – Gyan Yogyata Rozgar", "NEP 2020 – Gyan Yogya Ho", and informative lines like "National Education Policy – The policy restructures the education system of India. A

look at what the new education policy means for...". Some posters also directed viewers to official resources such as www.education.gov.in for further information.

Additionally, the rally prominently featured the IIPS NEP Thrust Areas, which include: Multidisciplinary and Holistic Education, Digital Empowerment and Online Education, Skill Development and Employability, Research, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Capacity Building of Teachers for Quality Education, Governance and Autonomy, Accreditation and Excellence, Equitable and Inclusive Education, Promotion of Indian Languages and Indian Knowledge System, and Internationalization of Education. These focal points were effectively communicated through the banners and enthusiastic participation of the students.

#### Report – IKS based Panel discussion relevant to different disciplines

A student interaction session was held on 29th August 2025, from 5:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M., at the MSD Classroom, 2nd Floor, Library Building, IIPS. Organized as part of the NEP SAARTHI initiative, the session engaged First Year Master's and Ph.D. students in an in-depth discussion on the Indian Knowledge System (IKS) and its integration within the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 framework. NEP Coordinators, NEP SAARTHIS, and senior research scholars participated actively, creating a vibrant academic atmosphere.

The session commenced with a warm welcome followed by an opening address by Prof. D. A. Nagdeve, Director & Sr. Professor (Additional Charge), IIPS, that underscored the significance of NEP 2020 in transforming India's education system. The Chair Prof. Aparajita Chattopadhyay, NEP Coordinator and Co-Chair Dr. Kunal Keshri, NEP SAARTHI Coordinator highlighted the critical role of IKS in providing a distinctive perspective to appreciate India's heritage, culture, and collective wisdom, aligning closely with the policy's vision of a multidisciplinary and holistic education system."

Prof. Aparajita Chattopadhyay, NEP Coordinator, conducted a comprehensive quiz on the Indian Knowledge System, encompassing a wide spectrum of topics including the history, science, culture, achievements and inventions from ancient through medieval to modern history.

During the core part of the session, discussants shared their reflections on various dimensions of IKS, covering its application across disciplines such as mathematics, geography, economics, and history. The dialogue emphasized how IKS enriches contemporary scholarship by grounding it in indigenous perspectives while fostering global relevance. The discussion also highlighted the current relevance of NEP 2020 in promoting IKS as a cornerstone for building a Viksit Bharat, fostering a Vishwa Bandhu Bharat, and aspiring towards a Vishwa Guru Bharat.

The session concluded with an open interaction where first-year students posed questions and engaged in meaningful conversations with the discussants. The event was wrapped up with a vote of thanks and a group photo, capturing the collaborative spirit and enthusiasm of all involved.


