

## **VISIT TO THE PARLIAMENT OF INDIA**

In response to the invitation from the Office of the Hon'ble Vice President of India, The International institute for population sciences -Mumbai organized a visit to the Parliament of India on 19th June 2025. The aim of the visit was to make students more aware about the parliamentary procedure and get a closer view of the legislative organ of the country the maker of all laws. After the brief introduction, the group proceeded for a guided tour to explore new parliament building (Lok Sabha Hall, Rajya Sabha Hall) where they witnessed the beautiful galleries created on the theme of diverse cultural heritage of India. Then the students were taken to the Lok Sabha which is built on the theme of the peacock and the Rajya Sabha built on the theme of the lotus. Both the houses of the new parliament building are beautifully decorated and equipped with modern technology. Students and Officials took opportunity of sitting in public gallery of both houses. The tour guide very efficiently explained conduct of parliament sessions & its preparation and elaborated upon various insightful facts about different hall and structures. The group was served lunch in the canteen of the Parliament.

Lastly, The students were taken to the old parliament building (Samvidhan Sadan) and they witnessed the central hall of the parliament where the historic transfer of power from Britishers to India took place in 1947.
