Dr. Sangeeta Desai acquired her doctorate in Women's Studies from SNDT Women's University, Mumbai. She also completed her MBA from Jamnalal Bajaj Institute of Management. She graduated from Narsee Monjee college of Commerce and Economics. She is the Co-founder of *Reright*, an organisation that focusses specifically on women's reproductive health rights. She is a consultant to Vacha, an NGO that addresses issues of adolescent girls and women living in slums of Mumbai. She is Guest faculty at the Research Centre for Women's studies at SNDT and teaches Gender and Development and Gender in Legal Terrain for the MA students. She brings in her corporate experience to her academic field and gives a taste of praxis and theory to her students. Dr Desai has started her own enterprise Inclusive Horizon which focuses primarily on women's health and is passionate about issues surrounding women's livelihoods, their economic and social empowerment.
