# Fifty Years of IIPS Library

The IIPS library has completed fifty years of its existence. The perfect documentation, regular procurement of demographic information sources, quick and smooth service, adoption of technology etc. are the unique qualities adopted by the IIPS library from the beginning and continued till today. We are presenting a brief reminiscence about our library.

## A BRIEF OVERVIEW

As we all know, IIPS was started as Demographic Training and Research Centre (DTRC) in July 1956 under the Directorship of Dr. K.C.K.E. Raja. Initially the centre was situated at Tata Institute of Social Sciences building, at Deonar, Bombay. For the main objectives of the centre - to provide training and to conduct the research on demography - a library was an essential section to support the activities and for documentation. Hence, the centre has started its library in February, 1957 with a small collection. During this period the responsibility of the library was given to the then librarian of Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mr. B.I. Trivedi.

From a modest start of 500 volumes since its inception, the library has taken a long leap towards equipping itself with a substantial collection of books, pamphlets and periodicals of demographic interest. During 1961 the library had a collection of nearly 4000 books, 2500 reprints and pamphlets, 80 periodicals, and microfilm copies of 40 census volumes (IIPS Newsletter, No. 4, 1961). The library was extensively made use by the students, staff members and other scholars in Demography and allied fields visiting Mumbai (Bombay). This was reflected by the fact that over 5000 issues were made during 1961-62 (IIPS Newsletter, No. 4, 1961).

## PROFILE OF THE PRESENT LIBRARY

The library is housed in a separate building and consists of a reading hall with a seating capacity of 80 users at a time and has well furnished conference hall of seating capacity of 40 with computer network connectivity to conduct academic programs. Photocopying, Inter Library Loan, Reference Service, Current Awareness Service, Selective Dissemination of Information, Indexing, Documentation, Document Delivery, OPAC are the major services provided by the library.

The library receives about 325 Indian as well as foreign journals, of which 175 journals are received by way of subscription and another 150 journals are received by gift/ exchange. More than 17,500 journal articles have been indexed and added in the library management software. The library has a special col-

Being established by the United Nations, as a Regional Centre of Asia-Pacific Region, the library gets almost all the publications from UN and specifically from UNESCAP and UNFPA. The important publications such as Statistical Yearbook, Demographic Yearbook, World Monitoring Report, World Population Prospects and World Population Policies etc. are available since its first volume in the series. The library adds on an average 2000 such documents per annum.

In 1960 the centre has shifted on its own campus. Initially it was occupying a portion of the main building (currently occupied by the administration section office, IIPS). On 19<sup>th</sup> June, 1982 the library has shifted to an independent new building. The library cum computer centre (G+2) building is centrally located in the campus, the first, second floor of the building is allotted for the library, the carpet area for the library measuring about 12000 Sq. Ft. It is centrally air-conditioned, well equipped with furniture, computer networking and internet facility.

lection of all the Census Publications of India & neighbouring countries which are made available through OPAC.

The library is fully automated with SLIM-21 software and offers online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) through a network of computers. The computers are located in different places in the library to ease the library users instead of centralized at one place. The library has books on different disciplines such as Demography, Statistics, Public Health, Family Planning, Anthropology, Mathematics, Economics, Sociology, Psychology, Health Education, Political Science, Geography, Computer Programming etc. published by the Union Government, State Governments, Corporate Bodies, International Agencies and Commercial

Publishers of India as well as abroad. There are 77,180 books, 13,108 bound volumes of periodicals and 15,844 reprints in the library. Seminar papers, conference proceedings, M. Phil. Dissertations, Ph. D. thesis are also been categorized as important reading material.

DDC 18th Edition of classification scheme has been adopted and AACR-2 cataloguing rules are followed in the library.

**SPECIAL COLLECTION:** The library has procured many old archival of journals to maintain the academic quality. It has a unique collection of Census Publications published during British Period (pre-independence period) i.e. 1881 – 1941, and

post-independence period since 1951 to the latest one. The library preserves the old traditions of effective services and enhanced them with the help of advance technology. Currently the library is in the process of digitalizing all the old census volumes (1881-1941) to provide the e-access through intranet.

### Digital Services

The library is using 'System for Library & Information Management' (SLIM-21) for its operation. The SLIM 21 provides search facility on two levels, simple search and advance search. Boolean operation search is extended in advance

search. A library user can see his/her library account on Web-OPAC on intranet as well as on internet. Browsing to view the new arrivals, list of holdings, and library rules are made easier through the OPAC. Introduction of the library as well as information about how to use the library is also provided in introduction and information part of the home page. Orientation of the library and the software is a part of the academic program of the Institute. Digital documents are accessible through a central server on intranet and are accessible by all the computers on the campus.

### a) *Online Services*

The Institute library has been fully automated and made available through online since 2003. It has enough computers with internet connectivity for students, faculty members and visitors. The library staff are very helpful in assisting every needy individual for library document retrieval and online data-base searching. The library collection is accessible through IIPS homepage at [www.iipsindia.org](http://www.iipsindia.org). From the main menu of the Online Catalogue, one can reach OPAC with a click. The library subscribes valuable information sources like, POPLINE, JSTOR, INDIASTAT.COM, SCOPUS; and they are made available through OPAC.

### b) *Offline Services*

Databases like, Census of India 1881, 1991 and 2001, DLHS, NUCSAL, NSSO and NFHS are accessible from NASSTOR. Special care has been taken to retrieve 2001 census data as desired by the library user. Series A – HH have indexed, prepared the table of all the titles in its sequence and hyperlinked with NASSTOR. It provides direct access from index itself.

The IIPS library is one of the active members of the INFLIBNET program. This is the national level program of the University Grants Commission. Offline database of National Union Catalogue of Serials in Academic Libraries (NUCSAL) and INDCAT as well as Document Delivery Services are extended to the library users. INFLIBNET website is [www.inflibnet.ac.in](http://www.inflibnet.ac.in)

The library is in the process of becoming a member of the NODLINET program and its facilities. (The IGNOU has launched NODLINET (National Open and Distance Learners' Library and Information Centre Network) program to assist the distance learning libraries in India).

### OTHER SERVICES OFFERED BY THE LIBRARY:

- The library brings out 'Acquisition List' containing bibliographic entries pertaining to the documents added to the IIPS library. It includes Books, Census Documents, Reports and

electronic documents. It is a bi-annual (January-June & July-December) publication. Online version of the Acquisition List can be provided on request.

- **SELECTIVE DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION (SDI):** The library informs to their clientele every week on their e-mail account as follows:

- a. List of research articles appeared in journals, edited books, conference proceedings, seminars especially on population studies and related disciplines.
- b. List of new books, journals available in the market on our subject.
- c. Library Acquisition list publication with the regular interval of a month.

- d. Submission of Book/Journal Requisition Form online.

- The library provides Inter Library Loan (ILL) service to the students, researchers, faculty members from all local libraries in Mumbai.
- Document delivery service - basically it refers to the supply of photocopy of research papers from journals or conference proceedings, against a request from a user with due consideration of Copy Right Act. The users can send their request either by telephone, post, E-Mail or Fax. The Xerox cost and postage will be charged and the desired material will be delivered.
- To promote the national language, Hindi, a bibliographical database has been made available in Devnagiri script and is accessible through OPAC. The results can be retrieved even if the query is in English.

The Institute library is organizing frequently the Book Exhibition in the library and the opportunity of selection of books extended to all the faculty members, students, including staff members. During 22-23rd October, 2008 the library has organized Book Exhibition. Prof. S. Lahiri, Ag. Director and Sr. Professor, inaugurated the Book Exhibition function. The Library & Information Officer, Registrar and some of the faculty members were attended.

The following persons have contributed to the management of the library as the librarians since its inception: Mr. Parkhi (1956-1957), Mrs. D.K. Boga (1958-1960) Miss. S. Abraham (1961-1985) Mr. R.T. Randeria (1986-2002), Mr. K.V.R. Rao (February – May 2002) and Mr.D.D. Mestri (since June 2002). One remarkable thing we would like to share here is, Mr. T.V. Sathe, one of our library staff, has worked with all the librarians mentioned above since its inception.

Consequent to the Millennium Declaration, in 2000 India too has integrated millennium development indicators in the planning documents. In post millennium declaration, emphasis has shifted from national and sub-national level planning to district level or below to strengthen the process of decentralized planning. In order to monitor at the lowest level of implementation (district or lower), it becomes important to understand the quality of available data and suitable tools to arrive at indicators that would help effective assessment of the programs in general and MDG indicators in particular.

To fill in the existing data gaps for computing millennium development indicators so as to enable preparation of State Level Human Development Reports, the UNDP has initiated a number of efforts. In this series, the UNDP awarded IIPS to undertake two studies namely, 'Strengthening State Plans for Human Development: District Level Vital Statistics' and 'Progress and Prospects of Millennium Development Goals in India' to address some of these issues. While conducting these studies, it was realized that the existing methodologies and the available data at the district level are often deficient or inadequate to address some of these challenges. Hence, it was thought appropriate to bring together intellectuals and experts working in the areas to discuss these issues and come up with possible solutions.

With this aim, a two-day seminar was organized at IIPS during 12-13 December, 2008, with the financial assistance from UNDP and UNFPA, New Delhi. The sub-themes for the seminar were, to discuss the progress of MDGs at sub-national level; Estimating Poverty; Knowledge and Utilization of SRH services; Infant and Child Mortality; Maternal Mortality; and HIV/AIDS estimation. Prof. F. Ram, Dr. Usha Ram and Dr. S.K.Mohanty were the organisers for this seminar.

Various national and International scholars, intellectuals and experts in this field have participated and presented their papers during this seminar. The seminar was inaugu-

rated by the Chief Guest, Dr. N. Tumkaya, UNFPA Country Representative, India. Dr. N.Tumkaya briefed the participants about the role of UNFPA in promoting MDGs in India. Prof. Ashish Bose delivered the key note address.

The Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India has setup a Population and Environment Centre at IIPS to collect and disseminate information relating to population, environment and sustainable development. A workshop of Indian State Basic Environmental Information Database (ISBEID) was held on 18<sup>th</sup> October 2008 at IIPS, with funding from the National Informatics Centre and Ministry of Environment and Forests. Ms Valsa Nair- Singh, Principal Secretary, Government of Maharashtra inaugurated the workshop.

ENVIS Secretariat has developed web enabled ISBEID software for State Government ENVIS centres to fill the collected data using web based online interface (with login and password authentication). The software is being developed for preparation of the State of Environment Report, keeping in mind the objective and advantage of storing this data on a database to finally generate the national level report on India's State of Environment. The GIS interface of the software is being developed by National Informatics Centre (NIC).

Dr S.P. Sharma, Statistical Advisor, Ministry of Environment and Forests explained the rationale of ISBEID, and Shri S.S. Gahlout, Senior Technical Director, NIC made a presentation of the ISBEID software and its interface with GIS
