Desirable: We prefer candidates with 1 year of experience working with Indian and international collaborators on public health or public policy research and / or prior experience with NFHS data.
Specific tasks	1) Liaise with GEH team in San Diego 2) Work on creating deliverables and ensure timely submission 3) Assist the lead and co-lead investigators in manuscript development 4) Assist in dissemination of the research outputs 5) Engage with expert policy consultants and a communications expert to support development of materials 6) Competency in advanced statistical analysis
