Applications are invited for one position of Junior Research Scientist under the GENDER Project, which aims to generate high-quality evidence on gender and health outcomes through advanced analysis of nationally representative datasets.

Position	Junior Research Scientist (1-Position)
Education qualification	Essential: Ph.D. in Population Studies, Demography, Public Health, Biostatistics or a related field with at least two peer reviewed research publications in the field. Desirable: Advanced statistical modelling and statistical programming skills, using STATA or R on large scale sample survey. At least two years of experience post Ph.D. working with Indian and international collaborators on public health or public policy research. Demonstrated leadership, writing policy briefs or contribution to peer-reviewed publications. <i>The experience requirement may be relaxed for deserving candidates possessing the requisite qualifications and skills, at the discretion of the competent authority.</i>
Specific tasks	1) Assist the principal investigator in manuscript development 2) Assist in preparation of policy briefs and dissemination of the research outputs 3) Assist in capacity building initiatives. 4) Work on creating deliverables and ensure timely submission.
Salary	Up to 1,40,000/- per month (Consolidated) based on qualification/experience.
