The council did not approve the study in the present form but advised to restrict to migration part of the project.

Agenda Item No. 7: Introduction of a new two years' duration course titled "Master of Arts in Population Studies".

The member secretary presented institute's proposal to introduce two years' duration MA programme in population studies.

The council made following suggestions:

- Economics may be given more space in the course.
- Term paper may be replaced by preparation of project proposal.
- Dissertation may be included.
- A batch may include a limited number of students, about 15-20 in number.

Council principally approved introduction of MA programme.

<u>Agenda Item No. 8</u>: Discontinuation of current Diploma in Population Studies, course.

The member secretary explained the need to discontinue the need to discontinue the DPS programme.

The council suggested to integrate the DPS with MA programme as and when the need arises.

Agenda Item No. 9: To review the progress of the research projects sanctioned during 2005-08:

The member secretary presented the progress of the different continuing research projects of the Institute as follows and the council noted the same:

It was observed that the Principal investigators of the Project entitled "fertility and Health Behaviour among Scheduled Tribes of Chhattisgarh" did not start the project during 2008-09.In fact, earlier Principal investigators were asked to do some preliminary analysis. The Principal investigators may take the same work in current year.

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Member Secretary presented the proposal to increase in the fee for different courses. The council members observed the steep hike in fees of some items. However the council approved increase in the fee as proposed.
